USA FENCING MEMBERSHIP



Fencing is a traditional sport deeply rooted in the history of the modern Olympic movement. It is one of the only four sports that have been in the program of all Summer Olympic Games.

Sword fighting is universal and that has helped the sport spread all over the world with not only rapid growth here in the US but also in the rest of the Americas, all over Asia and parts of northern Africa.

Countries like France, Italy, Hungary, Russia or Germany used to dominate the sport. Over the last two decades China, Korea, Japan, and especially the US have challenged the European dominance.

The US west coast is a big part of the growth. California has the largest number of fencers. In fact, it takes the combination of the second and third largest states (New York and New Jersey) to barely surpass the number of California fencers.



US Olympic Fencers fenced in an NCAA program since 2012




USA Fencing High School All Amricans come from the west. 9%
